Prices – vary from £3 upwards. In most cases, participants pay fees directly to the tutor.



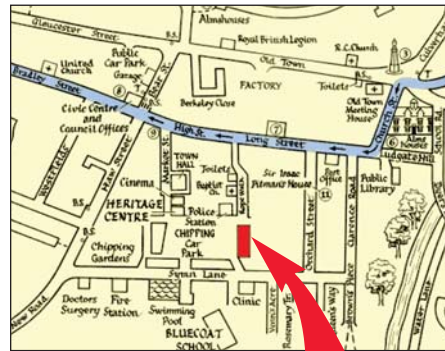
The Groove Project is a collective of young instrumentalists and vocalists
